

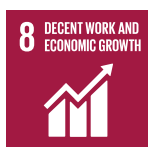

### Extending Smart Grids

Modernizing and expanding grid infrastructure to ensure a reliable and resilient power system by facilitating integration of variable renewable energy (VRE) sources



### Just Transition

Fostering an equitable and inclusive energy transition, ensuring that social, economic and environmental considerations underpin the shift to a green economy

## OUR WORK

ETP has implemented 70 projects in Indonesia, the Philippines, Vietnam and through our Regional program.

Through active engagements, ETP has:



Presented **26 policy recommendations** to align each country's regulatory environment with their climate commitment targets



Presented **10 de-risking instrument recommendations** to encourage more investments into energy efficiency and renewable energy projects



Developed **3 technical designs** and **8 technical recommendations** to improve grid infrastructure to allow more renewable energy integration



Developed **58 reports or knowledge products** to share new findings and research on energy transition initiatives and to rationalize policy recommendations



Hosted/ attended **126 knowledge sharing events** to increase awareness for better decision-making on energy transition in Indonesia, the Philippines and Vietnam
