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REGIONAL CONTEXT

- ▶ Southeast Asia faces the challenge of fostering economic growth while balancing climate commitments
- ▶ Urbanization and industrialization are driving a significant increase in energy demand (projected to grow by 3-4% annually) yet despite the rise of renewable energy sources, the region remains heavily reliant on fossil fuels such as coal and natural gas
- ▶ However, governments remain committed to transitioning to a sustainable energy future, aligning their Nationally Determined Contributions with the Paris Climate goals

OUR CONTRIBUTION

ETP's efforts in Southeast Asia extended beyond individual country programs. Our regional initiatives such as the Just Coal Transition and the ASEAN Power Grid Advancement Program (APG-AP) work on critical issues, such as equitable coal phase-down and cross-border power trade with increased renewable energy penetrations, respectively. Encompassing technical assistance, stakeholder consultations, and knowledge products, positions ETP as a key regional partner in the energy transition journey.

Support Coal Phase-Down and De-Carbonisation

- Unlock financial resources to support coal phase-down
- Provide practical knowledge to aid decarbonization efforts across ASEAN

Enhance Capacity and Knowledge Sharing

- Build capacity through peer-to-peer learning & knowledge-sharing efforts
- Drive sustainable energy policy development & collaboration across the region
