PROJECT SNAPSHOT

The coal value chain is complex and has interwoven socio-economic linkages with many direct and indirect jobs dependent on the industry. Coal regions have rural, mono-industry communities for which there are few livelihood alternatives for people and communities.

These prevalent conditions reiterate the importance of a just transition process which prioritizes people, environment, and new economic opportunities.

It empowers impacted communities to shape their future by co- creating plans and mobilizing resources to heal the land, support individuals, and build a sustainable economy.

ETP'S CONTRIBUTION

The Just Coal Transition Platform is a regional platform cofunded by the World Bank and the Southeast Asia Energy Transition Partnership (ETP). It convenes stakeholders in coal regions affected by the energy transition in Southeast Asia, particularly Indonesia, Vietnam, and the Philippines. The focus is on knowledge sharing, capacity building and enabling access to resources such as technical assistance and financial investments.

- Development of needs-based coal transition projects












